No position changes once shown to your spot

- No one may get on or off a moving vehicle entry (e.g., car, float, etc.)
- No dangling legs over the edge of a moving vehicle.
- No candy or other items can be thrown from a moving vehicle.
- Walkers may hand out items as desired. Candy must be gently 'tossed' underhand to the curb.
- All floats must be of the "pull behind" type on a trailer. Fire extinguisher recommended.
- Responsible adults must be present if children are riding or walking with a float.
- Vehicle driver pulling the float must turn hazards on.
- No real weapons/firearms allowed. Only exception is law enforcement.
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages.
- All floats should have an 8" clearance from the ground.
- Pull vehicle must be able to travel slow enough to avoid stalling.
- No fire or flame-producing devices allowed on floats.
- Horse entries must use manure bags and responsible for clean-up (bag failure).
- No offensive or profane signage or music permitted.
- The Carroll Community Festival reserves the right to deny or eject any entry that is not in the best interest of the parade and community. This is a family-friendly community parade.

Neither Carroll Community Festival, nor its members, shall be liable or held responsible for any personal injury or for damage or loss to parade entries or observers. Parade participants shall assume responsibility for injury or damage to personnel, property or observers resulting from negligence of their entry. By entering and/or participating in a parade, you agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Carroll Community Festival and the Village of Carroll from any claims, losses, injuries, death, or damage that result from acts of omissions of your entry and/or participants,
